1. Official college transcripts from the institution you graduated from and any other you received teaching credentials from. Two Letters of recommendation from another faculty member and the principal at your school. If you completed college very recently, one letter can be from a faculty member at your college.
2. A two to three-page (double-spaced single sided) personal statement indicating your intellectual goals in applying for the ESU TLab-UK Scholarship with a description of the specific course of study you would like to pursue through the programs offered as a part of the ESU TLab-UK (consult www.esu-tlab.org for more information) and your area-specific qualifications to undertake the program of study you select. Your statement should give evidence of your writing abilities, motivation, and your adaptability to new circumstances. Those of you who attend universities will be required to write papers which will be graded. Your statement should reflect your ability and willingness to write such papers. How do your objectives for studying abroad compare to the ESU's mission and objectives? How will you apply the personal experience of British culture in the 6-10 year period following your return home?
3. Please include 6 copies of your application, personal essay, Letters of Recommendations and your transcripts. Therefore a total of 7 sets of applications (1 original and 6 copies) should be included in a complete application.

Please note that universities in the United Kingdom do not always have access for individuals with physical disabilities.

Please ONLY print material on single side of each page. All double sided essays and letters of recommendation will not accepted.
